<u>Why</u>: 20% of the energy consumed by Europe's buildings is wasted, mainly due to inefficient maintenance, a lack of basic energy efficiency measures and poor energy efficiency behaviour by occupants. This waste represents a cost of approximately €270 billion every year, a figure that is set to increase to 53% by 2030 if no action is taken to curb it.


